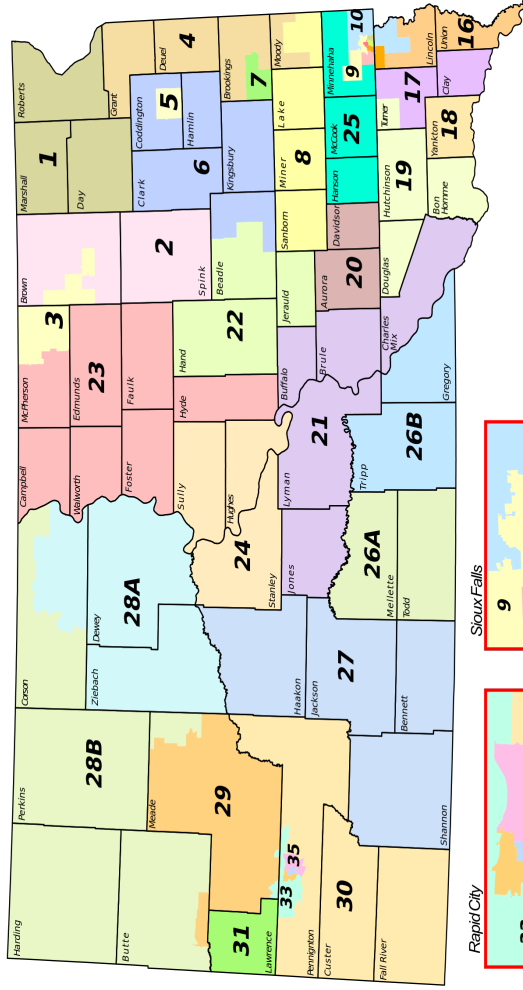

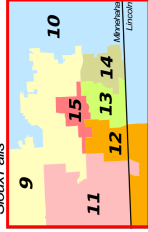

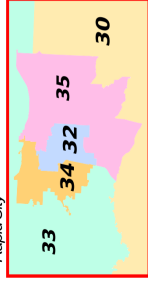
South Dakota Legislative Districts (Est. October 2011)

Legislative Terms of Office

Legislative terms of office are set by Article III, § 6 of the South Dakota Constitution which states in part:

...The terms of office of the members of the Legislature shall be two years.

...No person may serve more than four consecutive terms or a total of eight consecutive years in the senate and more than four consecutive terms or a total of eight consecutive years in the house of representatives. However, this restriction does not apply to partial terms to which a legislator may be appointed.

South Dakota Chamber of Commerce and Industry Legislative Review Process

The Board of Directors has the authority and responsibility to determine what issue positions are taken by the South Dakota Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

The Chamber's legislative review process is conducted throughout the year at quarterly Board of Director meetings. The Chamber's President and Chief Lobbyist is responsible for bringing issues to the Board that will be discussed during the legislative session. These discussions set guidelines and develop general positions aimed at articulating broad philosophical parameters on the issues.

The review process takes place during the Board's weekly legislative conference call. Rather than have a specific legislative committee, the board acts as a "committee of whole" in taking action on specific bills.

The Chamber's leadership understands that legislation can move quickly and that the President will need to make statements based on his or her best application of Board discussions on any given issue.
